

13YP - YEARBOOK PHOTOGRAPHY (70 points possible)

Students must upload five specific pictures, as well as quality captions/cutlines for each.

We want photos that obviously reflect the requested skills for pics 1-5. Still, we expect a bit more. Best shots should exhibit one, two, or more of the following photo ideals:

- Depth of field
- Unique Lighting
- Framing
- Emotion
- Cropping
- Leading Lines
- Frozen Action
- Angle
- Repetition

Students must submit the following five shots online by no later than the date of their school's chosen Regional registration deadline. Also, we will only accept pictures taken on or after November 16, 2022.

- **Pic1: Framing Shot** - Does the shot creatively frame its subject? What else makes this shot special?
- **Pic2: Academics Shot** - Judges will look for a unique academics shot that exemplifies multiple masterful photo techniques.
- **Pic3: Anything Music Shot** - Judges will look for a unique music shot that exemplifies multiple masterful photo techniques.
- **Pic4: Frozen Action Shot** - Does the shot freeze movement? We're looking for a high velocity moment.
- **Pic5: Best-in-Show Shot** - When we look at this shot, we should laugh, cry, gasp, or smile. Blow us away here.

Students must include full captions/cutlines for EVERY shot.

We expect at least three sentences here. One sentence must be a direct quote from somebody relevant to the shot. Judges will look for detailed and thoughtful captions that pay attention to proper grammar, conventions, punctuation, spelling... all without editorializing.
